

RED AND PINK

☺ **Peron Sprayless** - Bright red, 3 1/2 inch firm round fruit, sweet and delicious flavor, naturally disease resistant plant. Prolific, moderately vigorous, reliable in most climates.

☺ **Stupice** – Extra-early, cold-tolerant tomato. 2-4 oz salad size, very very sweet, delicious red fruit, one of the first to harvest and one of the last in fall.

Legend – Perfect smooth medium-large red round tomatoes. Sets fruit at cooler temperatures and strong tolerance to late blight. Determinate.

Early Girl – HYBRID. Bright red round tomatoes, good flavor and reliable.

Medford – Bred especially for southern Oregon. Red, round firm fruit, sweet and delicious flavor, similar to Peron. Crack resistant. Determinate.

☺ **Brandywine** – Very large, pink fruits with the wonderful Brandywine flavor. Very vigorous, high yielding. Only saved seed available, with small risk of cross.

Delicious – Very large, red tomato; Delicious holds the world record for tomato size. Some disease resistance.

Rose de Berne – Medium large round pink fruit, excellent flavor.

Sioux – Medium size, red tomato, supposed to have exceptional flavor.

Super Fantastic – HYBRID. Large round red very reliable tomato.

Italian Market Wonder – Large round fruits are beautiful and deep red.

Long Keeper – Late, medium size. Little flavor, but keep extremely well.

Shuntuksi Velican – Very large fruits, to 3 pounds, irregular and convoluted.

Palestinian – Heirloom with large irregular heart shaped fruits, to 1½ pounds, exceptionally delicious even in somewhat cooler, cloudier summers.

Stump O' The World – Late; large, 1 lb., pink, very meaty fruit with superb flavor.

Monte Carlo HYBRID – From France, excellent intense red & round tasty fruits.

PURPLE AND BLACK

Purple Cherokee – 8-12 oz., dark colored, best tasting tomato; less productive and disease susceptible, but worth it.

☺ **Black Prince** – Prolific, reliable, salad size burgundy fruits, great flavor. Tend to crack.

Purple Calabash Medium to small, flattened, highly ribbed dark purple fruit. Productive. Strong, unusual and complex flavor.

Black from Tula – Large black tomato, 3-4", Deliciously outstanding, rich, slightly salty, smoky-fruit flavor.

YELLOW AND ORANGE

☺ **Big Rainbow** – Huge yellow fruit with red streaks. Very juicy, with amazing sweet flavor.

Persimmon – delicious, large bright orange smooth round tomatoes.

Sun and Snow – Medium size slicer with iridescent yellow skin, snow white flesh.

Lillian's Yellow Heirloom – 10-16 oz., light lemony-orangey yellow tomatoes, nice smooth round globes, productive; mildly sweet, citrusy flavors.

GREEN

Green Zebra – Small/salad size green tomatoes, real tomato flavor.

Aunt Ruby's German Green – Beefsteak fruits, 5"x4", a pound or more. Sweet juicy flesh, refreshing spicy flavor.

☺ **Ananas Noire** – Uniquely beautiful and especially delicious! Very large tomatoes are green, purple, red, orange and yellow. One of the best tasting tomatoes of them all.

CHERRY AND GRAPE

☺ **Sungold** HYBRID – Taste test winner, small light orange cherry tomatoes are just the best.

☺ **Peacevine cherry** – Small bright red cherry in tresses. Exceptionally good flavor.

Mexico Midget – small ½" round cherry, round and juicy, strong excellent flavor.

Black Cherry – Dark purple medium size cherry tomato with excellent flavor.

Green Grape – Mild sweet large slightly elongated cherry tomato, greenish yellow

Chocolate Cherry – Dark brownish purple medium size cherry tomato.

PASTE

☺ **Federle** – Very large, long tapered paste tomatoes, very few seeds; good flavor.

☺ **Health Kick** – HYBRID. A large, firm, red plum tomato that rarely gets blossom end rot. Determinate.

Amish Paste – Very vigorous, aggressive plant, large red somewhat pointed meaty fruits with good flavor. Indeterminate. New source, from Peace Seedlings in Corvallis.

Orange Banana – nice, well-flavored paste tomato with an unusual bright orange color.

Romeo – HUGE paste tomato, in the 1½ pound range. Dense, soft flesh, good flavor.

Viva Italia – HYBRID, popular paste tomato, excellent flavor for a paste tomato. Determinate.

If you have ANY problems, a mislabeled plant (hasn't happened yet, but I worry), or even things like late frosts or wayward dogs, please let us know and we'll see what we can do to resolve it.

PEPPERS

SWEET

King of the North bell pepper – Large, cold tolerant red pepper. Mine kept turning red under tarps into November.

New Ace bell pepper HYBRID – This is the earliest, most reliable bell pepper I've grown; regular size peppers turning bright red when mature.

Cuneo bell pepper – Huge, bright orange, sweet, very thick walled bell peppers.

Jimmy Nardello Sweet frying pepper – long, twisted and wrinkled peppers, red and sweet.

Sheepnose Pimiento sweet pepper – shaped like a bell pepper, but much smaller; thick walled, very sweet. Early. I eat these right off the plant.

HOT

Early Jalapeño – The basic jalapeño, earlier than most.

Mucho Nacho Jalapeño HYBRID – Extra large jalapeño, supposed to be somewhat hotter.

Big Jim/Big Kim Anaheim type – Very large, long, moderately meaty, Anaheim type peppers. I have open-pollinated and hybrid strains, please specify if you have a preference.

Sonora Anaheim type – long green chili, mild-flavored anaheim type peppers.

Long Slim Cayenne – long thin very hot peppers, for drying. Reliable and prolific, even under less amenable conditions.

Serrano – Small, very hot pepper.

Bolivian Rainbow – (*Capsicum frutescens*) Decorative pepper, 1" teardrop shaped hot peppers turn from purple to red to orange. Saved seed.

TOMATILLOS

Purple tomatillo – This is the tastiest tomatillo I have tried, as well as productive of medium size dark purple tomatillos. We recommend growing two tomatillo plants to ensure pollination and fruit set.
